- Career and Opportunity: Audit and Taxation

- Audit division has approximately 900 employees that support a tax audit programs: Personal income tax, Multistate Corporate Tax, Residency, C-Corporation, Pass-through entities.

- We seek individuals that have these traits:

- Team building and teamwork
- Ability to multitask and prioritize assignments

- Classifications and salary ranges for tax auditor as of October 2014

- Tax Auditor Range A: \$3,168 to \$4,167
- Tax Auditor Range B: \$3,918 to \$5,151
- Associate Tax Auditor: \$4,711 to \$6,195

- After Associate Tax Auditor, there are two possible career paths: Program Specialist and Administrator.

- Program Specialist 1: \$5,178 to \$6,803
- Program Specialist 2: \$5,684 to \$7,473
- Program Specialist 3: \$6,911 to \$8,239

- Path 2: Administrator

- Administrator 1: \$5,178 to \$6,803
- Administrator 2: \$5,684 to \$7,473
- Administrator 3: \$6,915 to \$8,244

** Auditor in Chicago, Houston, and New York receives an additional \$346 each month.
