

LA County Auditor – Controller

- Government Agencies: Federal, State, County, and City.
- County departments: Auditor-Controller, Beaches and Harbor, Children and Family Services, District Attorney, Health Services, Parks and Recreation, Sheriff, 30 others...
- The LA County Auditor-Controller conduct criminal and administrative investigations of misconduct and fraud alleged against County managers, employees, contractors, and vendors including: contractor improprieties, theft of public funds/property, management improprieties, computer fraud/crimes, other improper activities.
- Department of Auditor-Controller Divisions:
 - Accounting
 - Audit
 - Countrywide Contract Monitoring Division
 - Office of County Investigations
 - Property Tax Services
 - Systems Operations
 - 6 others
- There are three divisions that are hiring:
 - The Audit Division: conducts internal audits of County departments including compliance audits of financial procedures and internal controls, management structure and organization, program effectiveness, and computer system integrity and security.
 - The Countywide Contract Monitoring Division: conducts fiscal and program audits of County contractors and provides other contract monitoring assistance and oversight for County departments.
 - The Office of County Investigations: conducts criminal and administrative investigations of misconduct and fraud by County managers, employees, contractors and vendors.

- Employment requirements:

1. Accountant-Auditor Minimum Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree
- 21 semester or 32 quarter units in accounting (including 1 course in auditing)
- Current legal right to work in the US.
- A valid California Class "C" Driver License

2. Desirable Qualifications

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Excellent critical thinking skills

- Compensation package: \$68,412

- \$4,543/month (\$54,516 for the 1st year)
- \$1,158/month cafeteria-style benefits plan offers:
 - Medical, Dental, and Life Insurance
 - Short-term and Long-term Disability Plans
 - Elective Annual Leave (up to 20 days)
 - Unused portion kept as taxable income
- 5.5% salary bonus for CPA, CIA, or CISA.

- CPA Qualifying Hours: All audit hours qualify. The LA County Auditor-Controller can certify. However, CPA is not a requirement for employment.

- Deferred Savings: 401K and 458 Deferred Compensation Plan. (Matching contribution up to 4% of employee's salary for each plan.)
